- Approval of revised rules and price list
 - Cllr. Mr. T. Edwards emailed the clerks at Abergynolwyn, Pennal and Llanfihangel-y-Pennant to enquire about prices of funerals in other districts. He determined that other Councils have a similarly interpreted pricelist based on the G.C.C. pricelist. It was passed by

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a majority vote to accept the existing pricelist. It was also suggested that a memorial garden could be an alternative option for families who do not wish to purchase the exclusive rights to plot. **Cllr. Mr. S. Quincey** will contact Heulwen at the funeral directors to discuss the matter further.

- The leaves on the path to the cemetery have become an issue as there is a danger the drain will block. **Clerk to email Liz Haines** to request the leaf clearing happens in the near future. Cllr. Mr. S. Quincey offered to clear any further leaves than fall on the path.

The wall by the layby café is due to be inspected by G.C.C. and they will report back their findings. **Cllr. Mr. S. Quincey** will contact the Forestry Commission again as he has emailed once regarding cutting back the hedges opposite the Rehoboth Chapel and from the end of the village to Gamedd Wen but has so far received no reply.

There is a trustee committee for the King George V playing field, this needs to be reviewed as some of the committee members have since moved or passed away. Cllr. Mr. T. Edwards and Mr. S Quincey to liaise with remaining members to move forward.
