- 14 Materion mynwentydd/cemetery matters.
Payment for grass cutting £200 approved unanimously
- 15 Institute proposed reopening of Post Office.
C.C.C. support the reopening of the post office provided safe entrance/exit measures, set out by the Institute, can be adhered to. **Clerk to confirm** decision by email.
- 16 Progress on King George V. playing fields.
The stipulations set out by W.A.G. mean that the King George V. playing fields can be opened for public use providing the guidelines are adhered to. Gatherings of no more than 2 households, area to be respected; no littering/ dog fouling. CUFC to take goals and netting down and provide bins. **Clerk to print** notices to be displayed stating these guidelines and warning of reclosure if not heeded. Passed unanimously.
Vote on the initial review of Titles to include obtaining Land Registry documents, was 3 in favour, 4 against. It was decided to take until the next meeting to gather more information. This does not affect registering with company's house and submitting accounts.



Cllrs. M. Olsson and S. Wells will proceed to a consultation in Corris Uchaf to ascertain whether any other parties are interested in purchasing the land. Any purchase will be under the condition that all costs are met by the purchaser. Vote carried unanimously in favour.

McCue suggested asking for quotes on repair/replacement of damaged equipment. It was agreed unanimously that **Cllr. McCue should proceed** with this by the next meeting.
Cllr. H. Lewis noted that the fence in front of the houses in Maes yr Orsaf is unsafe. **Clerk to contact** G.C.C. to request its repair be carried out.
